



XLeratorDB Helps The Sentient Group Enhance Functionality of its In-House Portfolio Management Systems

After searching extensively online for another option, Kumar uncovered XLeratorDB which allows Excel users, like The Sentient Group, to operate Excel-like functions in SQL Server, including XIRR, as well as other financial, mathematical, statistical and engineering calculations.

"Before XLeratorDB, there was no easy-to-use, built in solution for XIRR calculation in SQL Server," says Kumar. "XLeratorDB is the first product to bridge that gap and streamlines the process for us."

Kumar credits ease of use, reliability and concept understanding as the key differentiators for

XLeratorDB and expects the industry demand for XLeratorDB to grow in the coming weeks, months andyears.

"I expect a variety of companies and industries to find XLeratorDB very valuable, including companies and other institutions in the financial, education and software spaces," says Kumar.
